I am delighted to welcome our new School Secretary, Mrs Claire Hardie to our Staff Team. Mrs Hardie will be available in our school office on a Mon-Fri from 8.50-1.50pm.

Our Pupils Support Assistant Mrs Gallagher, Mrs Spark and Mrs Strachan will continue to support our pupils on varying days across the school week.

Clothing

As the weather is getting cooler, please remember to send your child to school with a jacket or coat. Please label all clothing and footwear with your child's name. Please can you ensure that your child has a pair of indoor shoes that they can change into on arrival at school.

School Uniform Swap Shop

Last term, in collaboration with our Parent Partnership we completed a 'Cost of the School Day report looking at ways that we can reduce or remove any costing barriers for our pupils and families. We discussed ways we could look to support our families with the cost of school uniform and plan to create a 'swap shop' bank of preloved pieces of school uniform which would then be available to all families on request.

Children can bring in water bottles to have at their desk throughout the school day. **Only water** can be taken in classrooms. Please put your child's name on the bottle. Please do not send any fizzy or diluting juice etc. Please note our Water Fountain remains closed until further notice.

Head Lice

To avoid continual school outbreaks of head lice, it is important that all parents check their children's heads regularly and at the same specified times throughout the year. We have designated the first Sunday in every month as our BUG BUSTING Sunday so please check your child's hair on that day. We will remind you of the relevant date each newsletter.
