## Summer Fete – 14<sup>th</sup> June

- Mia from YMCA is going to provide inflatables and people to man them for free. They also have an ice-cream machine, popcorn and pizza oven, but she does not have people to help with these. The ice-cream would cost between £30-£40 for 12 litres. The popcorn £10 - £20 and the pizza would cost nothing but we would need to buy the pizzas and toppings. We will contact Mia for more information on the pizza oven etc.
- Stall holders will be charged £10 per table.
- It was suggested that kids would be charged £5, given a wrist band and could use the inflatables as much as they want.
- A pick and mix stall was suggested. Face paints/tattoos. Toy/Chocolate tombola.
- Nicola to contact the community Police to see if they could attend
- Victoria to contact Fire brigade to see if they could attend.
- Nicola to contact Tayside contracts to see if they could do a BBQ and how much it would be
- We could try and find out if we could use tables from the hall
- Scratchcard fundraisers or 50/50 and sponge a teacher was suggested.

## Prize giving competition

It was suggested that we could hold an Art competition at the end of term. Separate competitions for class 1 and 2 with a return date of 13<sup>th</sup> June. Shiela Perera is to be asked if she could help judge. A theme was suggested that the children could depict something that they have learnt throughout the year. It could be any form of art from drawing, sculpting, painting, movie, photography. There would be a prize of art supplied and art voucher possibly from Hobbycraft.

## AOCB

- PKC have awarded £390 as part of their parent council budget

- With the above £390 in the bank there will be a total of £911.36 in the bank. The bus for the Mosque trip has already come out of this which was £500
- Mariesha advised that we will now be charged £4.25 a month service charge for the bank account. She is going to look into other options.
- We agreed to pay the bus for the Active kids trip next term which is £340
- Nicola thanked again for the Movie night and said it was a great success with the children still talking about it.
- Class 1 currently have a student teacher, Amy Carnan, until the end of March and then again after Easter.
- Class will also get a student teacher after Easter but for a shorter time.
- Nicola advised that the quiz team won the Rotary quiz for the first in a long time, if not ever. They now go on to the regional finals. Nicola also thanked Christine for all of her hard work in helping the team.
- There has also been a 1<sup>st</sup> place in the writing competition which now goes on to district level.
- Nicola advised that there are various other competitions – Young artist, young photographer, young musician, young sportsperson and young chef for Primary 4 to 7s.
- Class 2 have been doing a music project and are learning to read music, write music and play it. They will perform at the Easter service and there may be an opportunity to play at Perth Concert Hall.
- Lynsey Paterson of the PKC instrumental Music service has advised that the music budget will be discussed soon and from there will be able to advise if there is any allocated to the school.
- The class 1 & 2 drama club has been a success with class 2 performing at the Warm Space Cafe at the hall recently. There are plans for class 1 to do the same.
- The link for the Primary 7's next year for the Nethybridge trip will be sent out soon. It is a cost of £495 including transportation. There is a payment plan that runs from August to January. It will be discussed later in the year whether we have enough in the bank to put towards the trip. There are currently 9 pupils who could attend.
- The communication policy has been sent out again this week.
- Nicola asked for feedback on the new layout of the Newsletter. It was suggested that the Parent Partnership section could hold meeting dates and details on where the money is spent.
