#### Intergenerational group

Members of the intergenerational joined the meeting for a short time to explain their roles within the group and the school community. ## Future fundraising

- It was decided to book a delivery slot for the Christmas portraits items again this year. Due to demand the slots need to be booked now to ensure delivery in time for Christmas 2026.
- The first movie night of the year will be Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March at 3:15pm. Sandwiches seemed to work better so will be offered at this one also along with sweets and popcorn. Kymberley is to update the poster for this event. Parents must be reminded to book a slot and pay before the day. The children will be asked for suggestions for the movie.
- The Summer Fayre will be Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June from 11:30am to 1:30pm. Victoria is to contact Mia Brown (YMCA) to ask about inflatables again this year and the fire service to ask about a visit from the fire engine. Nicola will contact Pauline about serving the tea and coffee. Kymberley is to update the poster. It was thought that a poster drop could be done by pupils on the way to outdoor learning or the shop. An email will be sent to all previous stall holders.
- There could be a potential movie night on 26<sup>th</sup> June and 18<sup>th</sup> December. Along with halloween party on 30<sup>th</sup> October from 3:45pm until 5pm. It was thought that pupils could go home and get changed or stay at school and we could take them to the hall.

## AOCB

- It was mentioned that hotels and larger companies often offer help towards cleaning areas and helping with projects locally. This will be looked into.
- We need to investigate PVG's further as it does not seem to be an easy process.
- Nicola asked we could help with tea and coffee at the upcoming pantomime Aladdin Trouble. The intermission should be around 2pm.
- Nicola advised that the outcome of the "How good is our school?" questionnaire was really positive. The afterschool school clubs and committees were the only parts that scored slightly lower than expected. It was discussed that the after school clubs may be that they are not on the days that suit families or the activities are not enjoyed by some. The pupils will be asked what activities they would like to do.

- The committees are going to be overhauled in the future as part of improvement of communication and pupil voice policies
- There is a large amount of clothing in the swap shop at the moment. The items will be available at parent's night for families to take anything they want. There is so much that they may have to be recycled. It was also suggested that we could have sale of 50p an item.
- Nicola mentioned that due to budget cuts there may be a reduction in hours of PSA starting after the Summer and also funding for the Parent Partnership
