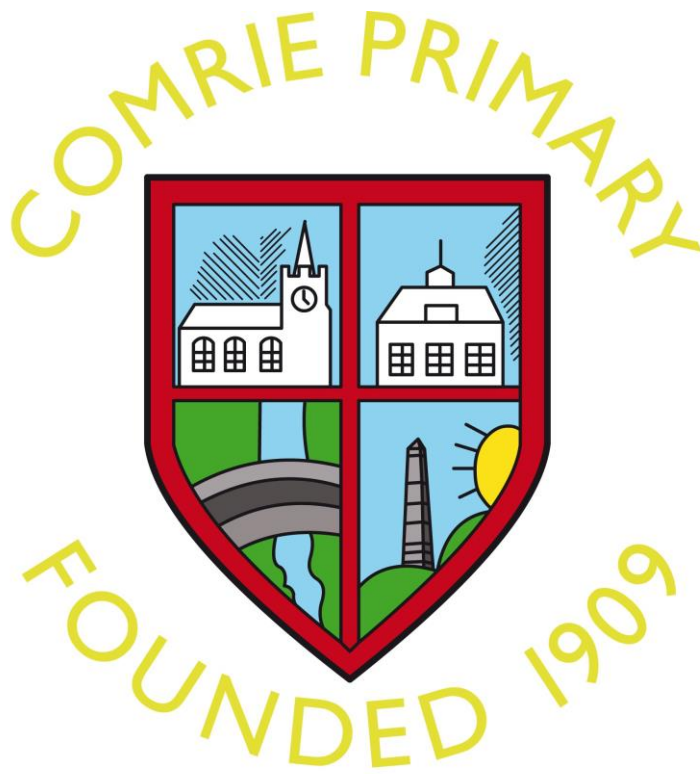
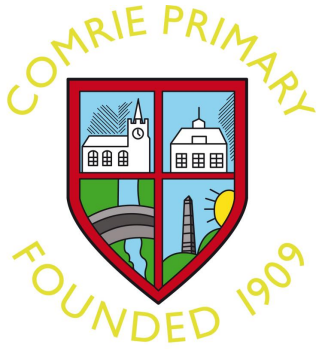

- **P7** children will be allowed down the street on a **Thursday** with parental permission.

Please provide a reusable bag for your child which can **remain at school**.

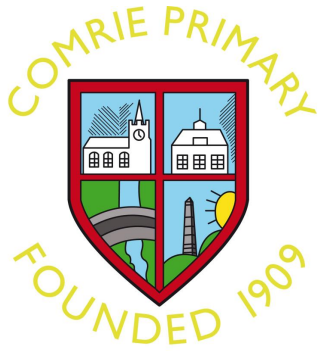

There is an expectation that my child will follow the school rules of being **Respectful, Safe and Ready** when down the street.

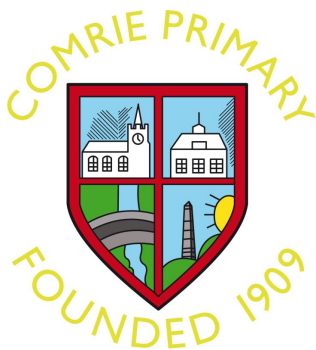
The children have interpreted this as documented below:-
