Happy New Year to everyone and I hope you all had a lovely Christmas holiday. The whole school is taking part in a learning context this

term which is The World of Work.

Teachers have been asking local businesses for their support. If you would like to come in and work with a class to talk about your own career we would love to hear from you, you can email the school address or phone and ask to speak to the class teacher or myself.

Nursery and P1 are looking at jobs in the school and in Coupar Angus.

P2 are planning on finding out about the jobs their parents do and they are also going to be running a café as part of an Enterprise project as well, planning how to set this up and what they will need to ensure they make a profit! P3 are looking at careers in Perth and Kinross Council, researching a variety of departments such as housing, education and culture. We have some exciting visitors lined up already from Building Standards, the Youth Services team and Trading Standards. Our classroom has become the 'P3 Council Offices' and visitors will be asked to report to our very own reception when they arrive!

P4 are focusing on IT and are looking at Careers with Computers. How people can use computers in their jobs, how computers have changed over time, how computers work and some of the computing-specific jobs we could do.

P5 are learning about Tourism and careers in tourism, as well as working with local artist Frances Law this term on the Coupar Angus Burn project. They have a visit to Perth Museum planned. P6 are focusing on Engineering. They will have the opportunity to put science, maths and design technology into practice in a way that will enhance their learning in the classroom.

P6 are taking part in the Scottish Engineering Leaders Award and will have the chance to think up and design their own invention. They will have the opportunity to interview real engineers and learn all about what it takes to become one.

P7 are starting the term planning their Burns Supper and then are moving on to focus on careers in journalism and have made links with DC Thomson.

Thinking Room 2 are looking at People at Work with a focus on skills, jobs using IT, work from home, working with other people, trades, earning money.

Thinking Room 1 will focus on jobs their parents do and then people who help us in school and in the community.

We have two very exciting events to invite you to this term. Firstly a Curriculum Workshop event on Thursday 9th February from 4-5pm, with a buffet tea afterwards and secondly a Careers event on Friday 24th March in the afternoon.

Nursery Enrolment is from Monday 23rd January to Wednesday 15th February. Even if your child currently has a place in nursery you need to reenroll them for next session. This is done via the school office, but nursery staff will also have forms available.
