Covid Updates

As you will have heard, Perth and Kinross has moving to Protection Level 3 from Friday 13 November.

The main additional restrictions that will be in place affecting schools are:

-Pupils in S4-S6 will be required to wear face coverings in class as well as in communal areas.

-Pupils in S1-S3 will be encouraged to wear face coverings in class.

The face covering rules in primary schools are that all staff who cannot socially distance from pupils should wear a face mask unless in nursery or P1 (where is the adult's choice to wear a face mask).

Where adults are providing close care such as nappy changing, working with pupils who cannot socially distance or applying first aid, they will wear PPE.

Parents are also asked to wear masks if entering the school playground and if they need to come into school for any reason (however, we are not encouraging any parents into school just now to keep everyone safe, it is only in special circumstances).

We continue to follow all our risk assessed plans in school such as good hygiene practices, ventilation in all the classrooms, social distancing and class bubbles.

If your child has any Covid symptoms we do ask you to keep them at home, to keep everyone safe and get in touch and we will arrange home learning.

We have applied for some I-pads to support some families with home learning (should the need arise) and for homework. If you feel this would help your family, please get in touch via the school email. We cannot promise an I-pad as we sadly do not have a huge supply, but we will try and it also helps us to know, if there was another home learning period, who would need an I-pad on loan.
