English, Literacy & Drama

Pupils studying Dahl will explore the murder mystery genre and develop their understanding of how a writer builds up tension.

Drama -Pupils are working on researching and producing a detailed mind map about the 5 basic Human Rights to inform their devised social-issue based drama. Then they will discuss, select and note down ideas for situations and roles.
