S1 Home Learning Week 3: 25 January - 29 January 2021



English, Literacy & Drama

English – Pupils will be writing a critical essay based on the poetry we have been studying.

Drama – Pupils will develop a character from the Macbeth extract, exploring the character through specific character techniques.

English & Drama – Support will be provided through Live Lessons on Microsoft Teams each period.

Social Subjects

Geography – Miss Logan's classes - We will be looking at why the UK has wild weather. We will have a live lesson on Teams which will be supported by a recorded lesson from Oak National and information in our class notebook. There will also be a quiz to check your knowledge and understanding.

Mrs Gilfoyle's class – We will have a live lesson on Teams to go over how we measure the weather. There will then be a quiz to check understanding.

Modern Studies - Classes will continue with the Crime and Law topic, looking at Community Payback Orders as an alternative to prison sentences. They will complete supported tasks on the purpose, advantages and disadvantages of this sentence based on live teacher input and recorded materials. Work will be posted on Teams (Google Classroom for Miss Fitzsimon's class).

History – continuing with Anne Frank – looking at her helpers and what happened to the family – team meeting-booklet work and further use of the virtual museum- work on teams.

Modern Languages

Learners will also be given time to watch the recorded Lesson and complete Teams assignments and quizzes.

PSE

Pupils will be learning about ways to manage anxiety and worry during the current lockdown. Introduction and discussion on Teams at the beginning of the lesson.

Music
