Weeks 4 and 5: 1 February – 9 February 2021



English, Literacy & Drama

Support will be provided through live lessons on MS Teams each period

English – Those pupils working on "The Telegram" will be creating their own short story inspired by their study of "The Telegram". They will also be developing their Close Reading skills.

Pupils studying Dahl will be creating their own short story based on "The Landlady".

Drama – Pupils are creating a short piece of drama about Human Rights. This week, they will have to experiment and agree upon the form, the structure and the dramatic conventions of their devised drama.

Social Subjects

Geography – We will start to look at the main features of tundra regions found around the world. Live lessons on Teams will be supported by independent tasks. A quiz will check your understanding.

Modern Studies - This week classes will use supported materials to create and conduct an online survey to gather the views of friends and family on the issue of policing. They will then use the results of this survey to write up a report. Mrs Russell will host a live lesson with pupils and recorded materials will be posted on Teams.

History – completing and presenting the research topic on conflict – the three periods should be used to finish off the research task. Staff will be available during period times to answer questions on Teams chat/posts. Miss Fitzsimon's Monday class, chat on google classroom. All PPTs to help the research task are on teams. Submission is due by Friday 5th February.

RME/Citizenship

Modern Languages

All S3 pupils will be learning and practising the new vocabulary on Daily Routine (at the weekend). There will be an online Live Meet to explain the tasks and give feedback, followed by links to Quizlet and Wordwall and Blooket activities (posted in threads) as well as Youtube videos. Learners will also be given time to watch the recorded Lesson and complete Teams assignments and quizzes.

PSE/PSU

PSE- Pupils will continue to learn about ways to manage worry and uncertainty during the current lockdown. Introduction and discussion on Teams at the beginning of the lesson and activity to complete on Teams. Pupils should also log on to Satchel One and read the Pupil Opportunities PowerPoint on the Announcements section.

PSU – Pupils will be supported to review their learning and to be provided with targeted support to overcome challenges. Teacher will be available on Microsoft Teams at this time.

Music

Pupils will be working on the following three elements:

Listening — Using your class notebook, listen to, take notes and demonstrate understanding by working through the Scottish concepts featured in your class notebook for this week. Resources are found by accessing the Sway relevant for this topic. There is a short quiz at the end of each lesson to check for understanding.

Literacy – Looking forward we are developing skills that may be useful for you should you decide to take music in S4. This work is set as an assignment.

Composition – Follow the short videos that have been created for you. This task is progressive and it is helpful if you can use an instrument or virtual instrument when taking part in this class. I would also encourage you to look at the suggested free resources you could use to support this which are listed in your class notebook.

Monday and Tuesday (8-9 Feb) will be used for consolidation tasks if you have music at this time.
