English, Literacy & Drama

Support will be provided through live lessons on MS Teams each period

English – Pupils will be continuing their creative writing work, with a focus on proof reading and editing skills. They will also be working on Close Reading.

Drama – Pupils are creating a short piece of drama about Human Rights. This week, they will have to practise to improve, increase impact, tension, emotion and the character depth of their devised drama.

Social Subjects

Geography – Pupils will be looking at how plants and animals have adapted to the tundra environment as well as how people live in this region. All work will be posted in the assignments section of our Team.

Modern Studies - Classes are progressing on to a new unit called "Social Issues - Crime and the Law." They should participate in a live lesson with Mrs Russell to explore the definition and categories of crime, then they will use supported materials available in Teams to research a recent example of a serious crime in Scotland and how this was investigated.

History – Pupils will be studying the Atlantic Slave Trade and African societies. NB Some pupils have still to submit their Conflict Research Task assignments.
