## English, Literacy & Drama

**English** – Mrs Basford, Mrs Forbes and Mrs McIntosh's classes will explore the beginning of "Of Mice and Men" by John Steinbeck.

Mrs Craig and Mrs Wilkie's classes will continue to work on persuasive techniques through the study of advertisements.

Support will be provided through Live Lessons on Microsoft Teams each period.

**Drama** – Pupils are creating a short piece of drama about Human Rights. This week, they will focus on practising to improve and increase impact, tension, emotion and the character depth of their drama. Live meets and resources will be on Teams.

### **Social Subjects**

**Geography** – Pupils will be looking at drilling for oil in the tundra, discussing the impact on the people and the environment. Live lessons will be held followed by some independent research on a case study.

**Modern Studies** – Classes will use this week to either consolidate their understanding of crime in Scotland and/or catch up on work from the last 2 weeks. They should participate in a live lesson with Mrs Russell at the start of the week then use supported materials to complete independent, skills-based tasks.

**History** – Continuing to deepen understanding of African societies pre and during the Atlantic Slave Trade with a specific focus on the Kingdoms of Mali and Benin – a mixture of live lessons, discussion, clips and pupil tasks.

#### **Modern Languages**

All S3 pupils will focus on writing and talking about their weekend at level 3 and level 4. There will also be an online Live Meet where the teacher will work one to one with pupils to explain the tasks and give feedback, followed by links to Quizlet, Wordwall and Blooket activities (posted in threads) as well as Youtube videos. Learners will also be given time to watch the recorded Lesson and complete Teams assignments and quizzes.
