## **Covid Update**

Thank you to everyone for your continued support in keeping our community safe by adhering to the national guidance at drop off and pick up as well as ensuring children are tested promptly if there is a concern and that school are kept in the loop as to results. Can I remind parents to arrive as near as possible to collection times, maintain SD whilst waiting and to leave promptly when they have their children.

There is quite a bit of congestion at the P4 P5 exit area so from Monday 27<sup>th</sup> October children in P4 and P5 who do not have siblings in other classes will leave school on the first bell at 15:05. This will mean that they can be collected and leave whilst parents with younger children to collect can be there by 15:10.
