Safe Routes to School

As you will be aware there are roadworks planned for Main Street for 2 weeks from Thursday 25th November. The side roads on either side of the school will be closed where they join Main Street. This will mean that cars will not be able to enter or exit Manse Road or Station Road from/to Main Street. I am concerned that if parents bring cars onto either of these streets to drop children and then turn near the school there will be traffic chaos and pedestrians will be put in danger because of turning cars.

I am requesting, therefore, that parents and children walk to school if possible and if this is not possible that parents leave cars at the far side of the park and walk through the park or park at the car park in Victory Park [across from The Institute] and walk down Station Road and into the school via the staff car park.

We will change the entrance and exit doors for P1/2 and P2/3 for the duration of the road works as the pavements at the front of the school are likely to be impacted by the road works. Children in P1/2 and P2/3 should come into school in the morning via the door they use at the end of playtime and lunchtime. [the children will know which door this is]. Children in P1/2, P2/3 and P3 will all come in and out of school via this door for the duration of the road works.

Staggered start and finish times will remain unchanged.
