The school is enjoying a hectic summer term with lots going on.

Sports Day

Sports Day took place on a beautiful sunny day. The Sports House Trophy will be awarded at the end of term service. This trophy is awarded to the house with the most points from all the sports day events and the "pre" events (see below). The final totals were very close!

Our individual sports champions received their medals on the day. The sports champion medals are awarded to a girl and a boy from each of our older classes. These pupils all take part in athletics (field & track) events in the weeks running up to sports day and are awarded points for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. The final points are awarded from the sprint on the day.

Cricket

Our P5s and P6s have been taking part in regional cricket festivals at North Inch and the Doo'cot Cricket ground. One P6 boys team and one P6 girls team made it through to the national final next week. Congratulations to them!

County Sports

Our P6 & P7 pupils are involved in lots of practice and then trials for track & field events early in the summer term. The winners of the school trials go on to represent the school at the County Sports Cluster event (with all the other Bertha Park cluster primary schools). This took place on Wednesday 31 May. All our pupils performed brilliantly and were able to proudly wear the new Dunbarney Primary School T-Shirts bought by our Parent Council.

The winner from each of the cluster events go on to the County Sports final on 20 June. Ten Dunbarney children have progressed to the finals (in a total of 13 events). The P7 Primary relay competition will be taking place on the same day.

Bridge of Earn Netball Club (the community club) welcomes pupils from P5 to U17s – please contact the club directly if your child is interested in training with them.



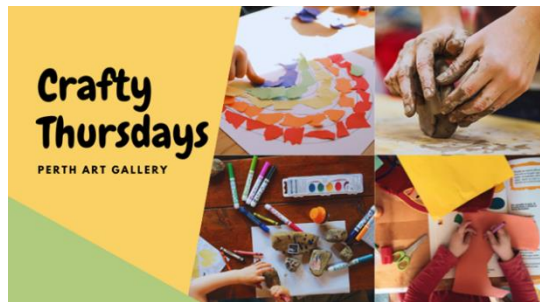
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Bikeability
