Class Information

By the end of next week (25/08/23), each class will receive information home from class teachers which will let you know all the important information you need for each class: PE days and arrangements for home learning etc.

Mrs Johnston has sent information home to each family about SeeSaw as this is our chosen tool to share with you what your child is learning in class and we use it as a communication tool to send home school information. For returning families, you will need to sign the parental agreement again - see email for details.

Families will receive a class planner each term, from Class Teachers, which summarises key learning in your child's class for that block, this will share the learning with our families.

Daily Uniform







Grey Trousers or Grey Skirt - not black, with either bottle green sweatshirt and white polo shirt or bottle green v-neck cardigan or jumper with a white shirt/blouse & school tie.

Black school shoes with black, grey or white socks.

A schoolbag/satchel/backpack – no handbags please!

Grey trousers, polo shirts, bottle green jumpers/cardigans/sweatshirts can be purchased from any supplier.

Green checked dresses or grey shorts and white polo shirt can be worn in the summer.

Outdoor Play & Waterproof Coats

We will be encouraging the children to play outdoors as often as possible during break and lunch as they need the chance to get the fresh air, run around and spend time with friends across the classes. Please can you ensure that the children come to school suitably prepared for the Scottish weather e.g waterproof coats and shoes (a change of socks in their bag is always helpful).

Communication

Email is the main method of communication. Our email address is <u>dunbarney@pkc.gov.uk</u>. This mailbox is checked regularly throughout the day. Please check your email regularly. Please email absences to this email address by 9.30am.

<u>Groupcall Text Message</u> is used for emergencies or if we need to circulate information quickly. It is also used for unexplained absences in the morning.

Seesaw is used by class teachers to keep you up to date with learning in class. *Please note: This will be the last academic year that we use Seesaw as our online learning/communication platform at Dunbarney PS and Nursery. Perth and Kinross Council have made an authority wide decision not to use/support this platform beyond 31 May 2024 in PKC schools/nurseries. Alternative online learning platforms are being piloted this year by schools in the authority. Our school subscriptions coincide with the date given and we will make a joint decision with staff, learners and families as to what we use moving forward in session24/25.*

ParentPay is used to pay for school lunches (P6 & P7), to collect permissions for events (paid or free). You will be contacted with details about how to sign up for ParentPay in the first few weeks. **ParentsPortal** is a service set up by the Scottish Government. It allows you to check and update all your contact details and we also use it to organise Parent Contact appointments. You will be contacted with details about how to sign up for ParentsPortal in the first few weeks.

The School Day

8.58am 1st Bell Signal to get lined up - P1 & P1/2 pupils line up outside the door closest to the gate on Manse Road, P2/3 Pupils at the Fire door close to the main back door, P3/4 – P7 classes at the main back door

9:00am 2nd Bell Class teachers and DHT / HT will welcome children into the classroom.

10:30-10:45am Playtime Children play outside and eat their snacks.

12.15-1.15pm Lunch. Children go to the dining room when their bell rings. The Class Teacher will tell them which bell it is.

3.15pm Home Time Children leave from the back door of the school into the playground.

Food & Drink

Children should bring a filled bottle of water every day. The bottle should not contain juice.

Snacks can be brought for breaktime (preferably healthy)

Lunch: Children make their lunch choice each morning in classroom.

School meals are free of charge for all P1-P5 pupils. Pupils may instead bring a packed lunch.
