

SCHOOL FUND Committee

In light of the fact that we are unable to timetable a School Fund Meeting due to staff commitments, this is an update of the current status (03/03/24)

We currently have a School Fund Uncommitted balance of £4,986.09.

We have a committed fund of £1700 for the trim trail repair set aside in a separate item (from an estimate).

The specific nursery fund stands at £49.55. This is for nursery specific items. The nursery sponsored event has not taken place yet so that should boost that fund. Nursery are looking for a big upgrade to their outside area. Funding for this has yet to be decided.

Requests for School Fund Committee approval

As you may remember, the Chair of the Committee (HT) is able to approve spending up to £100.

Could you consider the following please and email the Dunbarney email with your decision.

1. Trim Trail / Gazebo repair. Estimated £2000 (Parent Council are applying for a grant so this may be covered but we will have to retain funds until grant is awarded.

- Payment for P7 Trip. The Hardship fund provided by the Parent Council a number of years ago has been used up and now has £40. This was to be used at HT discretion and did not need SF Committee approval. We have asked the Parent Council to consider re-funding it.

We currently have 2 pupils in P7, both on Free School Meals, who will not be able to attend the School Trip. The cost for each would be £364.00 (£728 total).
