Update for Severe Weather Conditions

Every effort will be made to keep the school open for the children in normal snowy weather and it is anticipated that children who live locally and can walk to school should attend. It is recognised that children living out with the village may not be able to attend.

There may be, on occasion, severe weather conditions, which result in Luncarty staff being unable to travel to work. However, we have many primary teachers who live in the village and they will report to Luncarty school if they cannot travel to their own school. Therefore, the school will be open on most occasions. If weather conditions are too severe then closure will take place.
