<u>School Uniform</u>

As a school we ask children to come to school dressed smartly in school uniform on non-PE days and dressed for PE (Mondays and Tuesdays) in our PE kit as outlined below:

<u>School Uniform</u>

- Grey trousers, shorts or skirt
- White shirt and tie or white polo shirt
- A blue Luncarty sweatshirt, blue jumper, or cardigan
- Suitable (dark) footwear
- During the warmer weather, girls may choose to wear a blue gingham summer dress
- A pair of suitable indoor shoes to change into these should be kept in school

<u>PE Kit</u>

- Black jogging trousers, leggings or shorts
- Their 'House' t-shirt (Red, Blue, Yellow, Green)
- A blue Luncarty school sweatshirt or Luncarty school hoodie
- Suitable footwear / trainers

Please note that our PE days are changing to a Monday and Tuesday for all classes next session.

We do ask that for the <u>first week back</u>, <u>children all come to school in their school</u> <u>uniform</u> prior to beginning PE in week 2.
