3. Safer Community Team

- Manages the team of wardens
- Now merging with parking
- Training to have enforcement powers
- Community Support and Enforcement Officers
- Can support school's security
- Patrol nightly 7 nights a week
- They are proactive as possible and offer services to the local community
- Can support with anti-social behaviour, domestic violence, drug trafficking
- Operate in cooperation with police
- Property are now going to put anti vandalism paint or parts of the school roof
- If parents witness anything we can call the police or the Safer Community Team. Their phone line is open 9am-10pm 01738 476173
- The issue with football team parking will be monitored and could lead to parking fines

4. Head Teacher Report

- Mrs Masson will retire at the summer, Parent Council to organise a collection pot
- There will be a permanent Class Teacher post at Luncarty
- Restructuring within the central PKC team means there is a new Quality Improvement Officer, Kim Ramsay
- Standards and Quality Report will be published in June
- New flooring has started to be replaced. This will be an on-going project until complete
- Partition screen is now being used to section off the Peaceful Place to make it more of an individual classroom

- PEF funded resources for sensory equipment to support dysregulation
- Bowling will be beginning for all classes
- School team to represent at the Tullybelton Cup and League
- Sports Day- Nursery and new P1s will be joining
- Trips have been organised for all classes and Nursery considering Active Kids

 be beneficial moving forward.

- It was discussed that some younger classes feel like they are not getting enough communication and that there is a lack of information on Learning Journals
