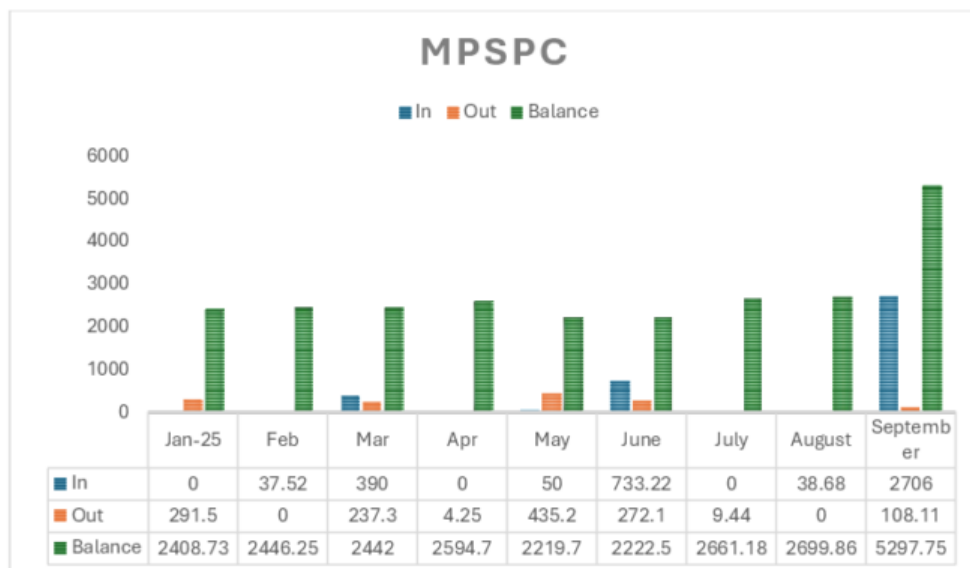


**TREASURER REPORT Jan-Sept 2025**
