Online Christmas Fair

Unfortunately we are unable to have our biannual Christmas Fair at the Huntingtower Hotel this year so we are having an online Christmas Fair to raise funds for an outdoor classroom structure, items or an outdoor musical area and more reading books. Each class will make items which you will be able to order and purchase through Parentpay. The children will also be producing a school calendar. You will be able to order through Parentpay from the end of Wednesday 25th November. Once you have decided which items you would like to order, please log into Parentpay. Each item is listed individually. All you need to do is put the quantity of each item you would like into your shopping basket and then pay for everything all at once when you check out.

We are making to order, so our order books will close on **Friday 4th December**, to give us enough time to make all of the items. Mrs Falconer will email to let you know when your

items are ready for collection. The children are also planning to make some limited-edition Christmas items. We will share pictures of these with you when they are ready to buy.

Parent Council Santa Sack and Luxury Hampers Raffle

Due to COVID-19 we've not been able to do our usual fundraising this year, but we have been able to put in place ways to allow us to do the festive fundraising through Santa sacks and raffle for hampers.

For the **Santa Sack** 3 winners will be drawn for cash prizes of £50, £30 or £20. Children will bring home 5 envelopes. If you would like to take part all you need to do is:

- 1. pop a pound coin in the envelope;
- 2. write your name on envelope
- 3. seal the envelope; and
- 4. ask the children to pop it in the box that will be located at the school by 9am on Thursday 17th December.

Raffle for hampers is a bit more complicated. Attached is the list of items we are hoping to receive through donations from parents to allow us to make up hampers. If you have any items that are not on the list they would also be greatly received and we will try to incorporate them. The number and types of hampers will depend on what gets donated, but usually we manage up to 11 hampers (Pamper Hamper, Rudolph's Feast, Santa's Boozy Basket, Afternoon Tea Treat, Chocolate Delight, Christmas Fizz...). To allow for isolation of items before making up hampers and again before they are handed out to winners we would please ask you to:

- 1. Review the list.
- 2. Advise Rachel what item(s) you would like to donate either by popping a note on the parent council Facebook page or sending an email to <u>rchalm2@hotmail.com</u>. This will allow us to monitor what items to expect.
- 3. By **9th December** ask children to drop items off in the donation box that will be located in the school (for bottles or breakable items can parents please arrange to drop these items off).

The Raffle will be drawn in the school on Thursday 17th December during the Virtual Assembly. Winners will be advised and arrangements made for picking up from school.

For purchasing raffle tickets the school have kindly offered to put an item on Parentpay so you can make payments remotely and note how many strips you would like to purchase (£1 a strip). We will then ensure your name is written onto the raffle tickets. The payment item for raffle tickets will also be available on Parentpay by the end of Wednesday 25th November.

Painting and decorating

We are excited to announce that the inside of the whole school is due to be painted over the next few weeks. The work will start this Wednesday 25th November. The gym hall will be painted first. Each class will then decant to the gym hall for a few days when it is their turn to have their classroom painted. We are looking forward to sharing photos of the school with you next term once all the work has been completed.
