1. Matters Arising from previous minutes

- SC will write a letter to parents outlining the funding issues facing the parental council
- 2. Finances since previous meeting (SC)
 - £487.25 raised from the coffee morning
 - £248.63 donation to Macmillan
 - £312 paid to Learning Journals
 - £301.60 Hoodies
 - Balance in parent council and parent pay as of 22/10/24 is £581.67
 - £94.55 is still in the school fund. SB suggested that this could be used to help pay for the hoodies
