To whom it may concern at Perth Kinross Council.

We are concerned with the implementation of the one way system that has been built along Castle Brae at Huntingtower. A number of cars are ignoring the one way system and causing a hazard. Some parents expressed concern that cars were having to mount the new pavement and that their children were in danger. In addition, the now way system takes no account of car parking at the end of the day. The council pays for taxis (with a side door) to take children to and from school. The taxi has to do a 3 point turn because the side door is now always facing the wrong way. Furthermore, the number of times that the Huntingtower road and/ or the Ruthvenfield road to the

new Bertha Park bypass roundabout are closed means that even more traffic is funnelled past the school. At 9am and 3.20pm this is causing considerable congestion. The road between the school and the Huntingtower hairpin turn is not wide enough for two cars in places. This is especially so at the crossing to Huntingtower halfway along this road. A number of times, children have had to step back or be pulled back due to cars not realising the lack of width. In short, this crossing has become very dangerous. We would urge you to have a two way system with lights between the castle and the bottom of the hill like you did when both the other two Huntingtower roads were closed at the beginning of August. In addition, we also urge you to have 20mph compulsory signage along the entire Castle Brae Huntingtower Road system with further warnings about the narrowness of the road at the crossing near Huntingtower.
