


EMERGENCY CLOSURE PLAN



Keep this guide handy for winter months.

As winter approaches, we want to keep you fully informed about what happens if an emergency closure is needed, for example due to power loss, heavy snow or icy conditions. Closures may be decided by Perth and Kinross Council for all schools or locally by the Headteacher for safety reasons. We will do everything possible to keep the school open, but only while it remains safe to do so. Wherever possible, we aim to make consistent decisions with nearby schools. The safety of pupils and staff is our top priority.

When there is a school emergency closure, announcements will be made as soon as possible from the following sources:

School will sent a Groupcall email to one designated email address.

NB there may be a delay if staff have attempted to travel to school and encountered difficulties.

If the school is **partially open**, children can attend the school if safe to do so. Parents should make the decision whether to send their child to school. Please contact the school office by email (ruthvenfield@pkc.gov.uk) to inform us. If the **taxis** does not operate in the morning, but the school is open, you can bring your child to school. If the taxi is not running at home time, you will be responsible for collecting your child.

Our **school meals** are delivered from Bertha Park High School. It is possible that in unusual circumstances, Ruthvenfield Primary School may be open when BPHS is closed due to severe weather. If this occurs, we will contact parents to advise as soon as the information becomes available. This will be by Groupcall email.

CLOSURE DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

If the school needs to close during the day due to worsening weather, we will:

- send a groupcall email to your designated contact to arrange an early collection
- phone parents / carers or emergency contacts of children who have not yet been collected
- hand your child over to you or a nominated emergency contact

Staff who live further away will be released first, while local staff remain until all pupils have left. The school will close once the last pupil and staff member has left.

Our aim is to evacuate the building as soon as possible therefore please plan ahead: **You should begin to arrange alternative childcare now if you may be unable to collect your child promptly. Please ensure your emergency contact details are up to date with the school office.**

When the school is closed to all pupils, remote learning will be provided. Staff will work from home to deliver this learning.

In the first instance, your child should complete any homework activities and reading they have.
