

## Bargarran Primary School Community Café

This session as part of our Pupil Equity Fund plan all Primary 6 and 7 pupils are undertaking the JASS wider achievement awards. As part of the JASS awards the children are starting a Community Café. The café will take place once a month and is being organised as a social enterprise project. The first two dates the café will be open are Friday 2nd November and Friday 7th December. The children have organised a non-uniform day on Friday 12th October to raise money for the purchase of resources that will be used to start the café.
