
Dear Parents and Carers,

What is it?

Our homework will now be accessed through Glow Google Classrooms, the online portal we used for all learning and teaching during Lockdown.

How does my child access it?

Google Search: Glow Login



Your child will have their own username and password, given to them by their teacher. They should log in with these details.

Once they have logged in, they should click 'Join'.

When your child has 'joined' the class, the teacher can then assign homework to them. If, for example, your child joins today or tomorrow they should be able to see the work that has been set by Wednesday or Thursday. This first piece of online homework will run until the end of next week, in order to give everyone time to log in and access the work.

Any reading books given out will be returned as normal on Thursday for quarantine.

What if we have problems accessing the work?

We have created several ways to support your child in accessing their Google Classroom.

1. On our school website, in the 'How To' section and under 'Digital Skills' you will find the support videos we have created.
2. Should you prefer to speak to someone regarding this please do not hesitate to call the school where we can arrange for a member of our teaching staff to call you back and talk through the process.
