Mathematics

Sorting by colour, shape and size.

Numbers 0-12: recognise, write and count.

Language

Single sounds: recognise and write. Begin using sounds to make simple words.

Social Studies

Time to Talk is a cross-curricular topic, involving listening and social skills. Time to Talk was used as a transitional topic by both Glenburn and Glenfield Nurseries. We will also cover social skills such as sharing and turn taking. After the October week, the children will begin to learn French.
