Primary 6/7 Homework Programme

Session 2019/2020

Primary 6/7 is an important year for your child as they prepare to go to High School or venture into their last couple of years of Primary School. Homework is an essential link between school and home and therefore your support in this matter is very much needed. Below you will find a guide to what is expected of your child in P6/7 each week and also each term with respect to homework.

Spelling

Spelling homework will be given out on a Monday for the full week. Your child should complete all four spelling tasks and they will have until the Friday to complete it. Each Friday there will be a spelling test and it is important that your child revises their words for the test. Spelling test jotters will be sent home on a Friday to be signed and returned on Monday.

Reading

Reading homework will be issued every Monday. Your child should prepare the pages for Thursday as they have associated tasks to complete.

The content of their reading book should be discussed in order that it is fully understood and also that any unknown vocabulary is looked up in a dictionary to ensure your child knows the meaning. If your child is doing a novel study, he/she will be expected to complete a reading log entry or associated tasks each week.

Maths

Maths homework will generally be given out at the start of the week. This should be completed for the Friday of the same week. Occasionally there will be no Heinemann related homework, therefore on these nights, revision of times tables would be beneficial. In addition to this, there may be mental maths homework issued.

Topic

Topic assignment homework will be given out twice a year. This will be in Term 1 and Term 2.

PLEASE NOTE – The school cannot print out topics handed in on U.S.B devices or C.D. format, due to council regulations.

French

Revision and consolidation of French vocabulary will be occasionally required, e.g. numbers, colours, days of week etc.

Listening/Talking

Your child will be asked to prepare a 2 minute talk in Term 1 and Term 3. They will be given 1-2 weeks to prepare the talk at home and they will present it to the class.

It is important that all homework is checked for errors, corrections made, then signed by parents or guardians.

Finally, please check and sign your child's homework diary.
