## Playground Safety

The rubber mesh, which is currently in place, meets health and safety requirements, however, we feel that a more cushioned/ softer surface will prevent any further incidents from happening. Unfortunately, a P3 child injured herself on Tuesday afternoon. She is doing well and on the mend and was extremely brave. We wish her a speedy recovery.


