## Relationship, Sexual Health and Parenthood Education

Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood (RSHP) is a key element of the health and wellbeing curriculum and helps to prepare children for changes in their body and relationships. Auchenlodment Primary School and ELCC is committed to the provision of quality RSHP Education in accordance with Local and National Guidelines and are using teaching resources available on the online national toolkit www.rshp.scot

Parents and carers are children's primary educator and RSHP education is best taught in partnership with parents and the school. The rshp.scot resource acknowledges parents and carers need to understand the content of the lessons their child will receive so they are able to reinforce and consolidate learning at home. This will also ensure that terminology used at home complement the child's learning at school.

Throughout this term and next term staff will teach RSHP education throughout the school.
