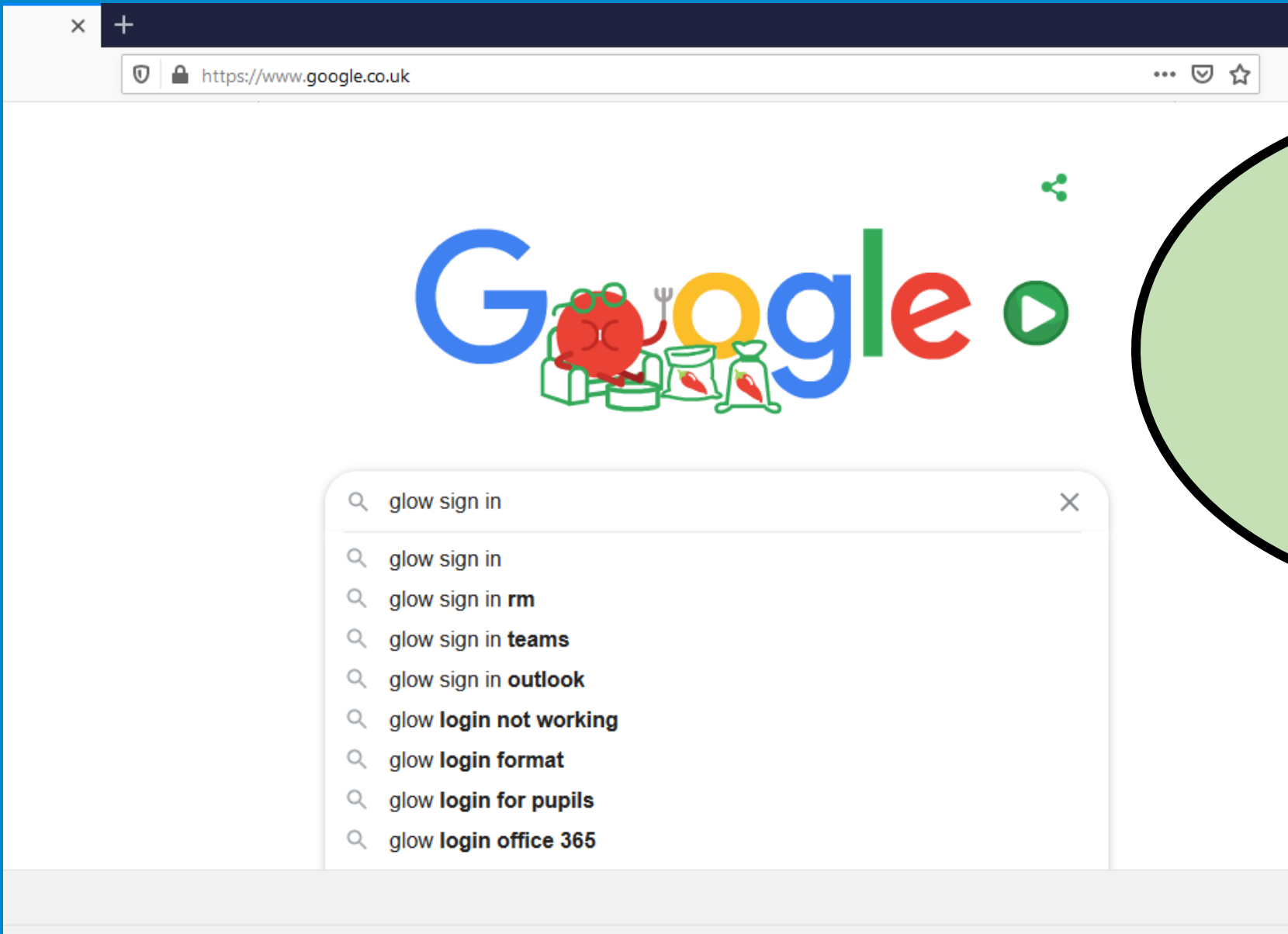




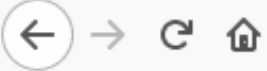

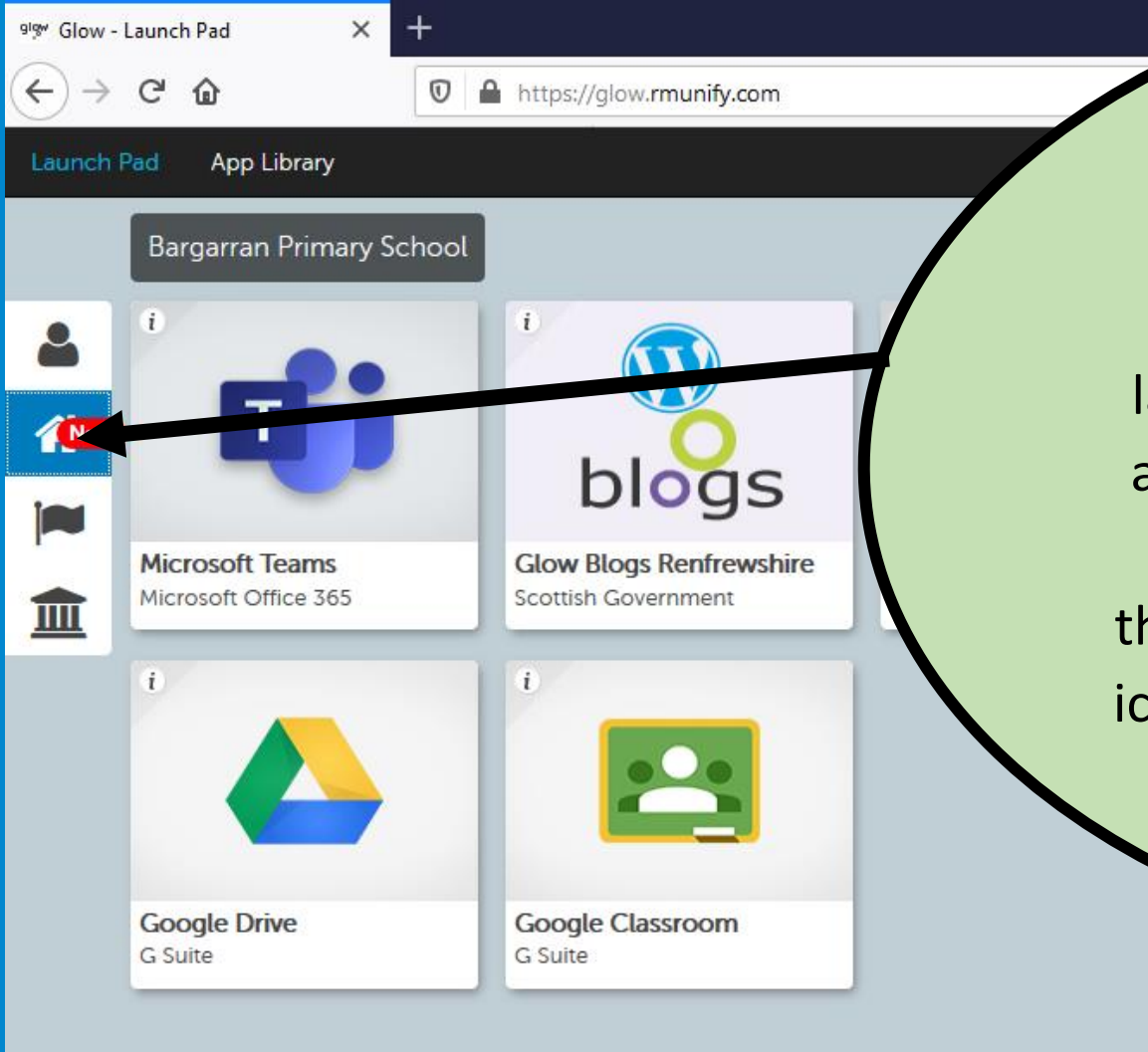

If this is the first time you've logged into Glow, you need to accept cookies to continue. You will only need to do this once. Click the box to accept cookies and then click 'Launch RM Unify'





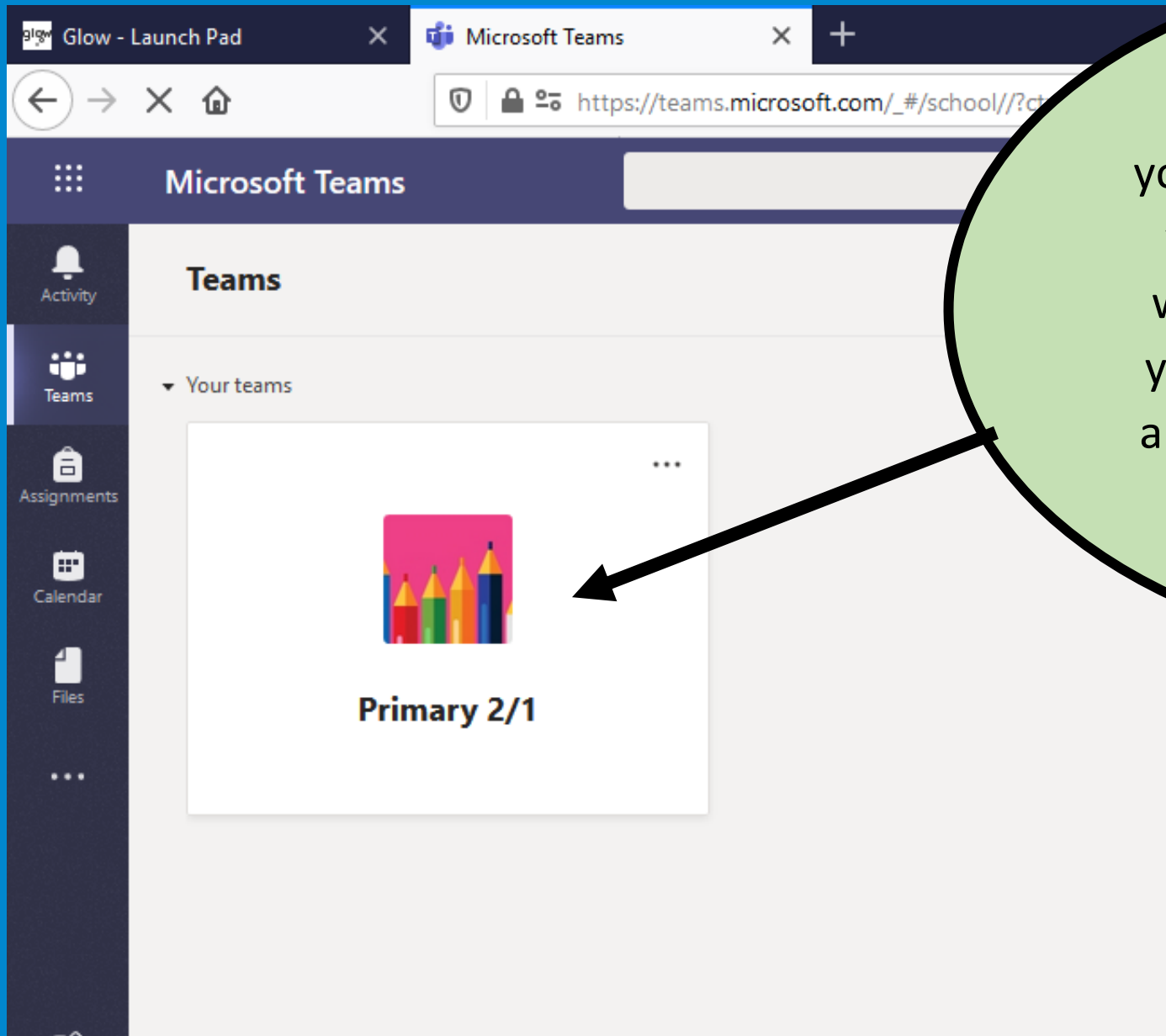
This will take you to your launch pads. These are places where you can access 'apps' or as Glow calls them 'tiles' to launch programmes quickly. These can be accessed down the left side of the screen. The main launch pad you will be using is the schools launch pad which is the 'house' icon. The launch pad being shown is always highlighted in blue.





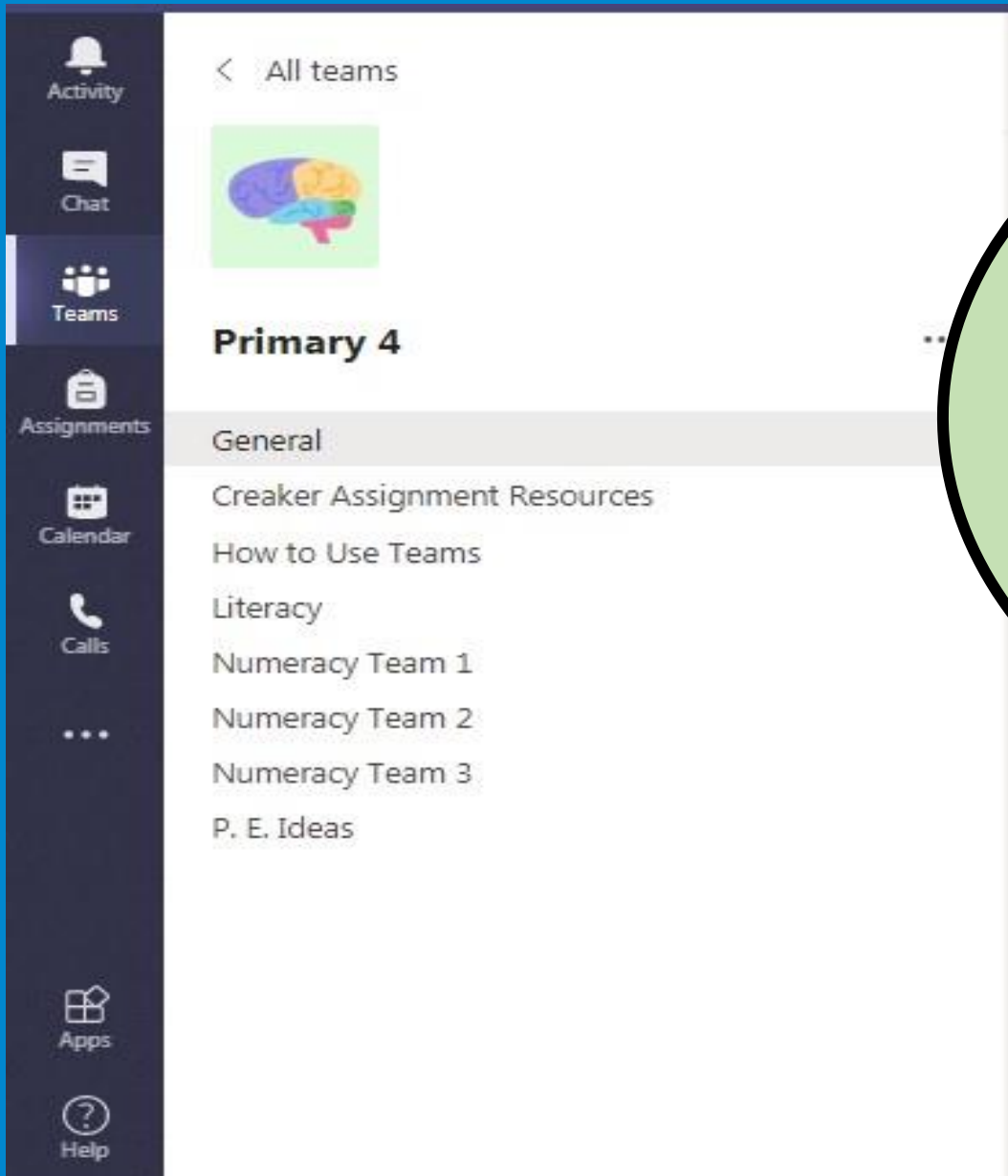
Only teachers can add tiles to the school launch pad. They might add ones which are useful to you. We are going to be using Microsoft Teams which is the first tile on the school launch pad. Click on the tile to continue.





This will open a new window in your browser. You should now see your class on the screen. This is where you can access work from your teacher, ask them questions and submit completed work. Click on your class.





You will have access to all the channels your teacher has created. The channels are just a way of separating working into curricular areas to make things easier to find. Your teacher might start off using the 'general' channel and gradually add more as the weeks progress.

For this piece you need to include:

- At least 2 different settings - 1 can be from our story (like Whiffington, the Woleb, Lucy's house etc.) and 1 new setting for your story
- A clear, detailed and sequenced story - it must flow properly from one part to the next. So you'll need good descriptive words, paragraphs, captial letters and full stops (have you got that - capital letters AND full stops!)

Take time to plan it carefully using the sheets I will upload. Enjoy and have lots of fun.

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

These are all questions Tom Fletcher doesn't answer as I told you. So you need to use your imagination and imagine what happens next. So that's your assignment for this week after our story the Creakers!

For this piece you need to include:

- At least 2 characters** - 1 from our story and 1 new character (your own imagination run wild!)
- At least 2 different settings** - 1 can be from our story (like the Woleb or Lucy's house etc.) and 1 new setting for your story

Once you finish your work, close down the Word Online tap, scroll back to the top of your assignments page and click 'turn in.' This submits the work for your teacher to read and give feedback.

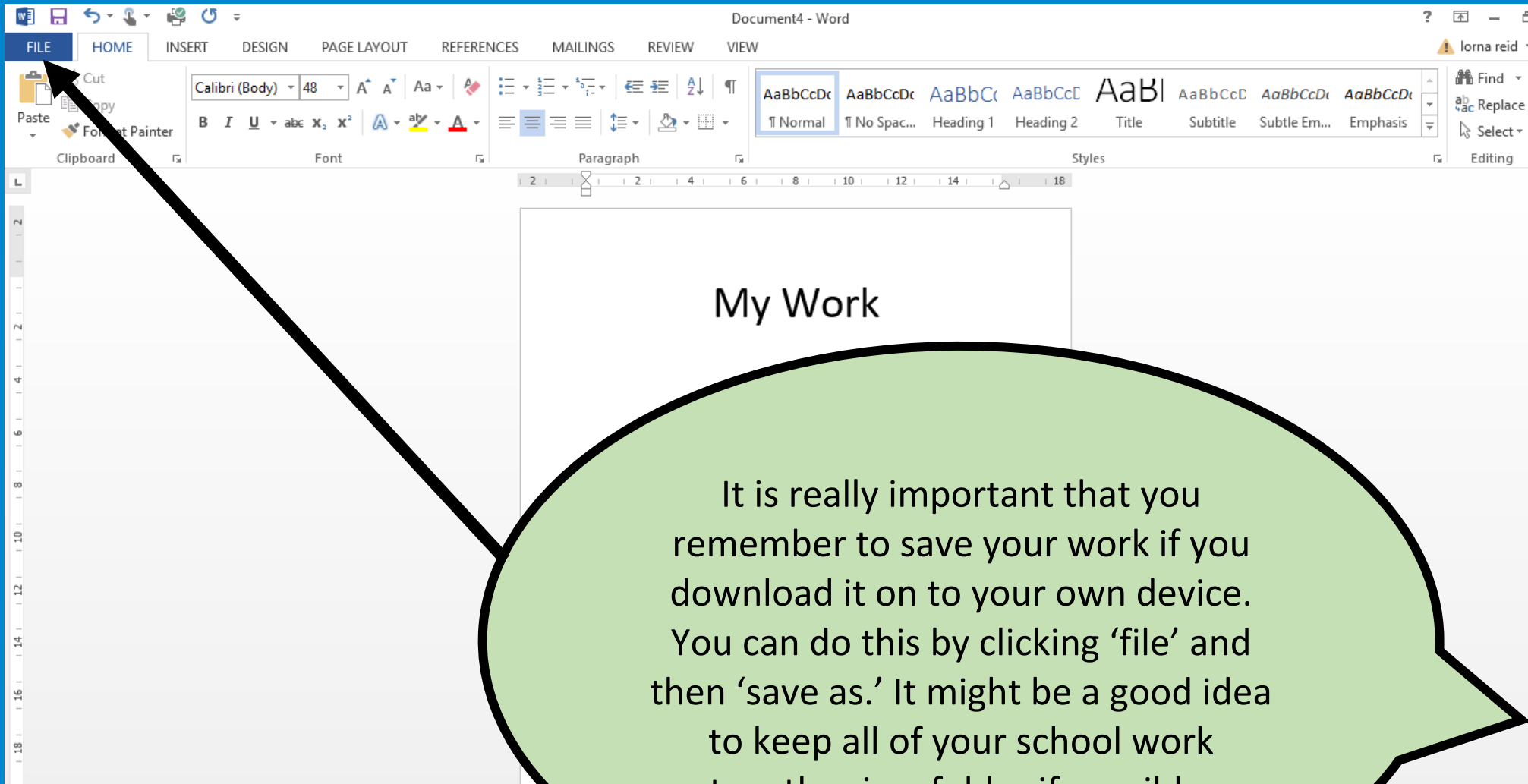

If you download the document then you are working on it on your own device. You will need to complete it using your devices version of Microsoft Word.





It is really important that you remember to save your work if you download it on to your own device. You can do this by clicking 'file' and then 'save as.' It might be a good idea to keep all of your school work together in a folder if possible.

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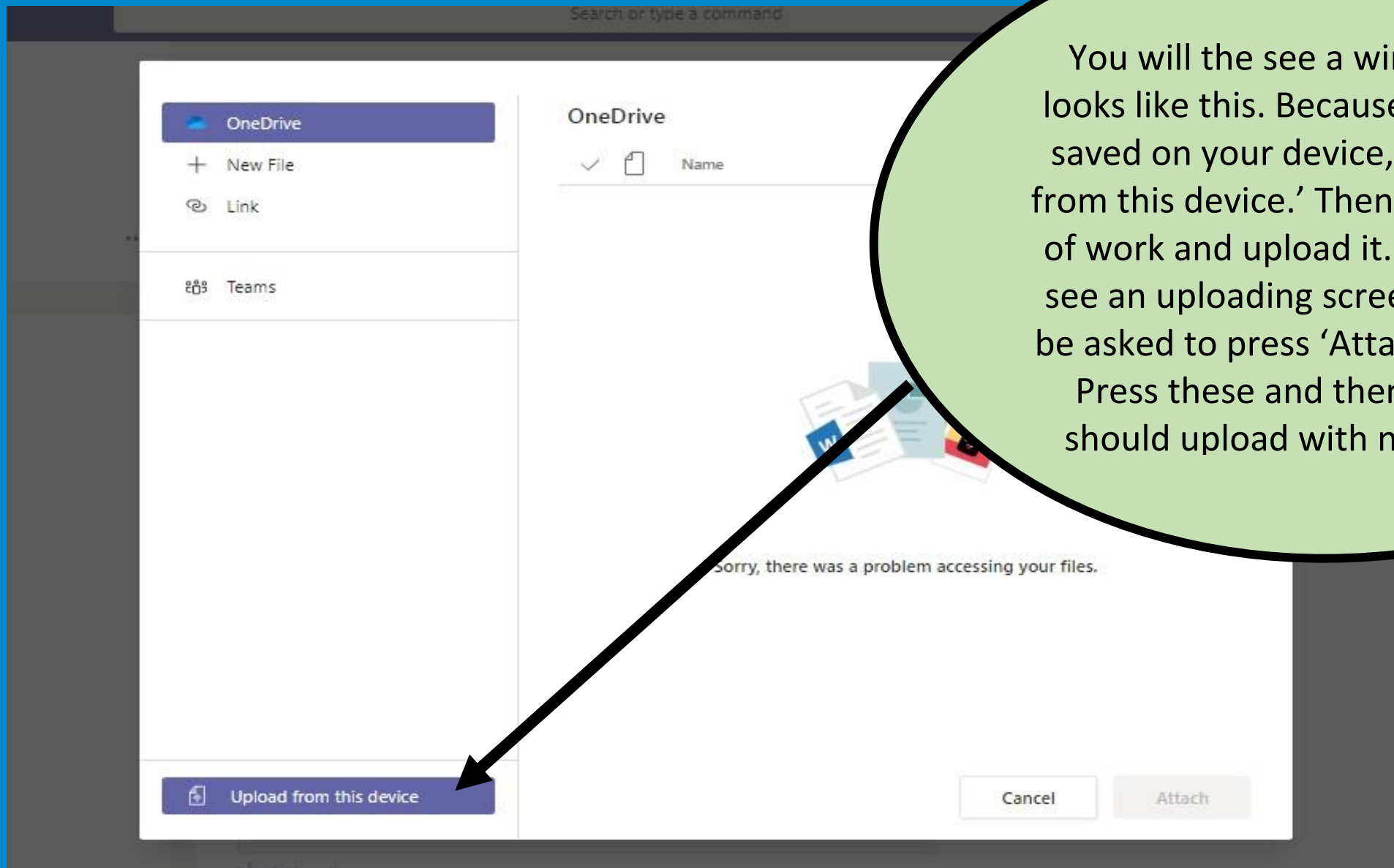

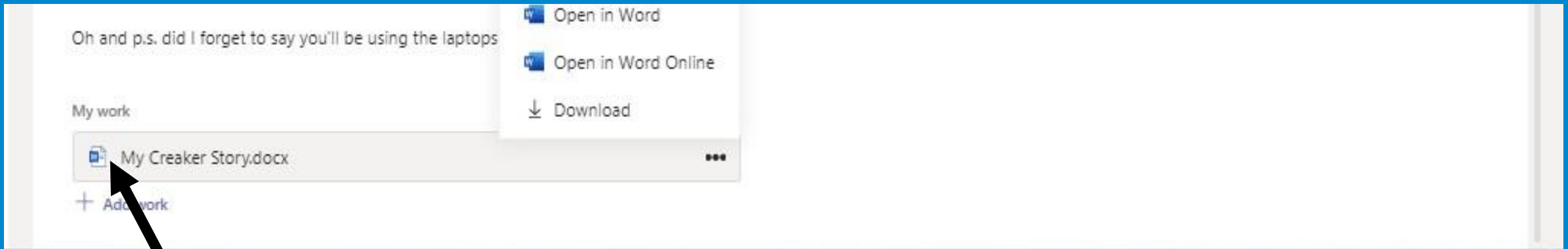
When you work is complete, you will need to return to assignments and scroll down to the bottom. Click to add work button to upload work from your computer. **Please note this is also how you would upload any photographs of your work that you want to show your teacher.**





You will see a window which looks like this. Because your work is saved on your device, click 'upload from this device.' Then find the piece of work and upload it. You will then see an uploading screen. You might be asked to press 'Attach' or 'Finish.' Press these and then your work should upload with no problems.





You should see the document you have uploaded above the add work button. You can add more documents or photos if you need to.
