The report will highlight strengths of the school and next steps for improvement. The next steps will guide the content of our future improvement priorities.

#### School Staffing - Mrs Mackenzie

We recently informed parents and carers through Class Dojo that Mrs Mackenzie is taking early retirement and is leaving Bargarran Primary on Friday  $20^{th}$  December.

Mrs Mackenzie has been a member of staff at Bargarran for over 20 years. She has taught at a range of stages, held the position of Principal Teacher and for the last six years Depute Head Teacher. This included a spell during the Covid closures when, in the absence of the Head Teacher, Mrs Mackenzie ensured all the mitigations were in place for the school to open again in August 2020.

Mrs Mackenzie will be missed by everyone at Bargarran Primary. We are sure all our parents, carers and children will join me in thanking Mrs Mackenzie for all she has done for the school and wishing her all the best for her retirement.

We will provide an update on our plans to fill Mrs Mackenzie's role as Depute Head Teacher in due course.
