As a rising number of our pupils are bussed to school please ensure that adequate space is left for the bus to park.

Renfrewshire Council have launched a Schools Parking Pledge which will be issued to you child shortly. We hope you will sign up to this safe parking initiative.

Personal Belongings

Last session we had an incredible amount of lost property throughout the school.

Please ensure all of your child's belongings are labelled with their name so that we can return lost items to the rightful owners.

If your child has misplaced an item please come in and have a look in the lost property at the main entrance.

If the item is not there please inform a member of staff and we will endeavour to track it down

<u>Medicines</u>

Schools are only permitted to administer prescribed medication that must be taken during the school day. Should your child require medication, a form must be completed by an adult and the medicine handed to the school office.

Asthma inhalers should be with pupils at all times. Older pupils may wish to carry their own or staff will keep them safe in the classroom. If inhalers are kept in school please check regularly with the class teacher that they have not run out and are still in date.
