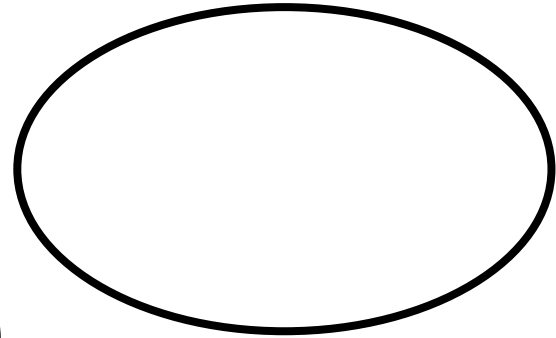
Transition into Primary 1 Home Learning Grid

Colour in the boxes to show what activities you have done. Share this with your Primary 1 teacher when you start school.

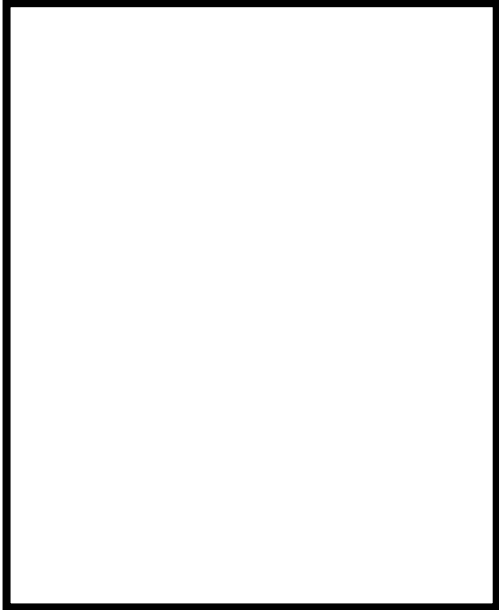

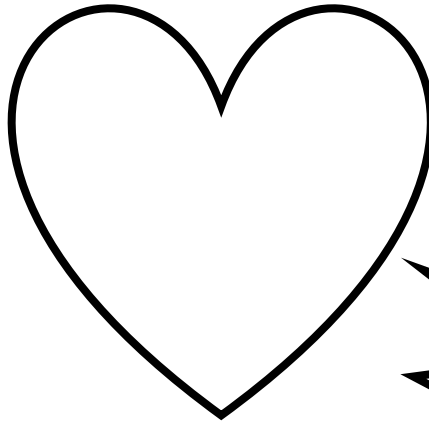
