Dear Parents/Carers,

As you will be aware, the Director of Education, Steven Quinn, announced in a letter to parents last week that schools are planning to open for transition activities in the period between Thursday 18th and Tuesday 23rd June. This will allow Primary 7 pupils to attend high school and return to Brediland in groups across the aforementioned four dates.

Pupils will be grouped based upon their respective Gleniffer houses. Your child will visit Gleniffer on **either Thursday 18th or Friday 19th June** and attend Brediland on **either Monday 22nd or Tuesday 23rd June**. Pupils should wear their hoodie with school trousers or a skirt on these days. Information about the visit to Gleniffer can be found on the letter posted alongside this one on the school website.
