Looking ahead to session 2021-2022

**School Uniform** — Reminder that from August all of our children should be back in school uniform. The Brediland uniform is grey trousers or skirt, white shirt or polo shirt and blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan. Trainers are allowed, as we continue in our drive to learn outdoors in all weathers!

Class bubbles and playground bubbles will continue from August, until such times as we have more updated information. Also, plastic school bags and a range of stationery will again be provided for your child in August. Each child will continue to use their own resources, provided by us, to avoid sharing and risking the spread of the virus.

We will also continue to operate a staggered entry and exit, meaning that Primary 1 to Primary 4 will come in to school from 8.50 AM and leave school at 2.50PM. All other classes will come in at 9.00AM and leave at 3PM.
