Annual Data check and other forms:

Your child will be issued with the usual annual forms, please ensure these are completed and returned to school asap. It is of the utmost importance that we have correct contact details for every child, therefore if there are any changes after these forms are submitted please let the school know in writing.

Plastic school bags and a range of stationery has again been provided for your child. Each child will continue to use their own resources, provided by us, to avoid sharing and risking the spread of the virus.

We will also continue to operate a staggered entry and exit, meaning that Primary 1 to Primary 4 (including the P4's from P4/5) will come in to school from 8:50 AM and leave school at 2:50PM. All other classes will come in at 9:00AM and leave at 3:00PM.

Just a reminder that **physical distancing and wearing masks** continues to be a priority for safety within Brediland. This extends to the playground and the street outside the school when dropping off or collecting your child.
