The children now all know their class and teacher for next session, and the following information is also important to note for starting back in August 2022:

- School Uniform reminder that all of our children should be back in school uniform. The Brediland uniform is grey trousers or skirt, white shirt or polo shirt and blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan. Trainers are allowed, as we continue in our drive to learn outdoors in all weathers!
- Please note that next session, we_will continue to operate a **staggered entry and exit**, meaning that Primary 1 to Primary 4 will come in to school from 8.50 AM and leave school at 2.50PM. All other classes will come in at 9.00AM and leave at 3PM.
