Children should not be using their mobile phones to take videos or photographs within the school grounds.

Children should not be bringing other electronic devices to school to use at break times or golden time. At Bushes we like to encourage children to build friendships and relationships with one another and find that the use of such devices at these times does not support this.

Registration of Infant Beginners in Primary Schools Session 2020-21

Children who reach 5 years of age between 1 March 2020 and 29 February 2021 inclusive should be registered in their catchment area school as follows:

Pupils whose surnames begin with initials A to L should be registered on Wednesday 15th January 2020.

Pupils whose surnames begin with initials M to Z should be registered on Thursday 16th January 2020.

Registration will take place between 1pm and 3pm on each day. If you are unsure of your catchment school, please contact the school office staff who will be happy to help. Parents should produce their child's birth certificate, and two proofs of residence, which must include council tax notice for the property or proof that you have registered for council tax at that property, and a letter from your solicitor confirming that missives have been concluded, a rent book for rented property, tenancy agreement or a mortgage/bank statement. **Original documents** must be produced.
