- Council have advised that having a school crossing patrol not a guaranteed service and that parents are responsible for their own children to get to school safely. If we need to take this up further, we can contact the council directly.
- It was brought up that the yellow zig zag lines outside the entrance of the school are now very faint and we are seeing more people parking very close to the school gates. Craig will check who is responsible for this and get back to us.

Playground Maintenance

 We discussed the email Craig sent re some of the quotes to fix the climbing frame area. At the moment, a few patch up repairs need to be completed due to trop hazard, but bigger decisions need to be made re the climbing frame area. Option to repair or replace and we agree that this needs the involvement of the wider Parent Forum as this will be lot of money. We do not have the full funds needed and options to look at grants and potential to raise funds with the help of the school community.
