

Whole School Trip to Kelburn Country Park

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to be able to write to you to inform you that we have booked a whole school trip to Kelburn Country Park. The trip will take place on <u>Monday 20th June</u>. The buses will be leaving at <u>9.30am sharp</u> so it is imperative that all pupils arrive on time to allow pupils to be registered and organised to be on the bus on time. The buses will return us to Bushes in time for children to be dismissed at 3pm as usual.

Thanks to a generous donation from the Parent Council, alongside a contribution from the school, I am delighted to inform you that this trip will be <u>free</u> for all pupils. I am also very grateful to Mrs Wake who has been working hard to plan and organise this trip for the pupils.

Ahead of the trip there are a few things I need you to do:

- 1. Please log onto your child's Parent Pay account and give permission for them to attend this trip. This needs to be done ahead of the trip otherwise pupils will not be able to attend.
- 2. Please email us at <u>bushesenquiries@renfrewshire.gov.uk</u> as soon as possible if you know your child will not be at school that day e.g. due to a planned holiday. This will allow us to book the correct number of buses and admissions to Kelburn Country Park.
- Complete the tear off slip attached if you wish to order a packed lunch from the dinner school for the day of the trip. This option is available to all children including any who are eligible for free school meals. This needs to be returned by <u>Wednesday 1st June</u>.

Lastly, to enable this trip to take place we are in need of a large number of parent helpers. We need around 30 in total and would ask if you are able to help us on the day that you email or phone us as soon as possible. Please only do this if you are certain that you can come. I have to make it clear that you may not be used to support your child's class on the day depending on where the volunteers we receive come from.

I am sure, on behalf of your children, that you will be as excited for this trip as we are, and we are looking forward to what will be a wonderful day for the whole school. Fingers crossed it will be the sunniest day of the year so far!
