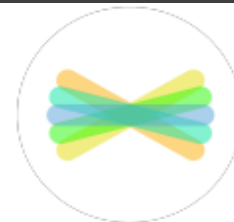

Seesaw

What is Seesaw?

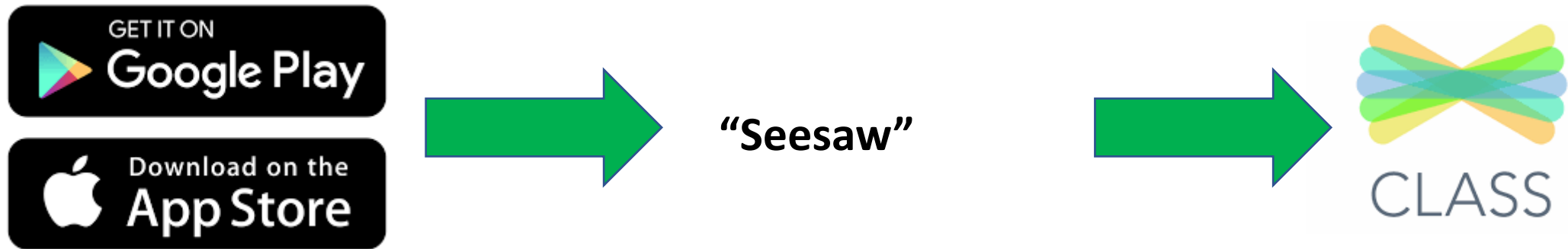
- Seesaw is a web-based learning platform that allows your child to share their learning from school with you at home via various apps.
- It is a great tool to celebrate success, communicate with parents and get an insight into what is going on in school
- You can access Seesaw through any Android, Apple or other smart device



Seesaw

Which app to use?

- Seesaw has two apps and we use both at Bushes.
- To keep things simple, we are only going to introduce the Seesaw Class app just now.
 - This app is for pupils to log in and share their learning but it can become a little confusing when using both apps at home.
- To access the app, search for “**Seesaw**” on your app download service:



- If you prefer to use a PC/Laptop, search “web.seesaw.me” online.

- **Student Login (Home Learning Code):**
 - When a pupil signs in, they can upload to their Journal from the app.
 - This could be a response to a homework challenge or a photo from an afterschool club etc.
 - If the teacher set Seesaw activities, pupils can access it via their login.
 - You must keep your QR code, especially if more than one child is sharing a device for Seesaw. The app is very secure and doesn't allow two Seesaw accounts to be logged in at the same time. Annoying but safe!
- **Family Login:**
 - The family member account does not let you upload to the journal but let's you view your child's journal.
 - If you have more than one child using Seesaw, the family login lets you quickly switch between their journals to view messages from the school

Use the QR Code or Text Code

These codes will be on the “Home Learning Code” sheet
An example is on the next page.

Family Invite Codes are different and are used to log in as a parent. Useful if you have multiple children in the school.

Home Learning Codes

- These codes are not to be shared out with your household.
- Seesaw is a secure learning platform which allows pupils to share with confidence.
- Leaking QR or text codes is prohibited.
- This is the 16 digit text code
- This is the scannable QR code



Angus Bannerman's Home Learning Code

1. Go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer. Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS or Android device.

2. Choose "I'm a Student".

3. Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account: **FPUP** **Masked for Security**




Ask your teacher for a new code after May 13, 2023.
This code is a password. If you have this code, you can access this account. Do not post codes on social media or in any publicly accessible place on the Internet!

Home Learning Codes

Keep your codes safe!

- If you have more than one child attending Bushes Primary, you'll need to sign them in separately each time they want to use Seesaw on a shared device.
- It seems annoying, but it ensures pupils confidentiality and online safety.

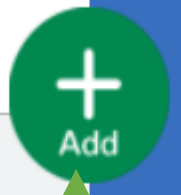

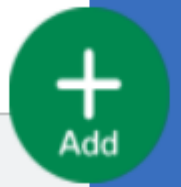

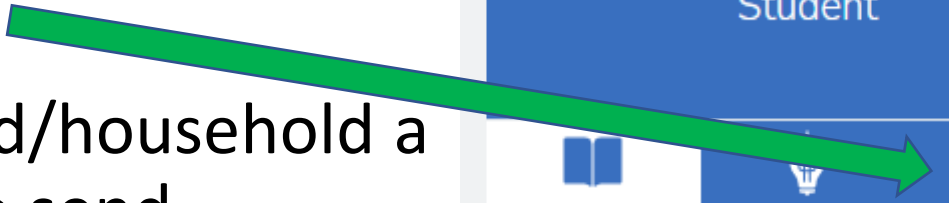
