1. Finance Update

2. Uniform Recycle Scheme

- Ali estimates that she has 30-40 school jumpers available
- Some unbranded items have been donated e.g. shorts, trousers & plain polo shirts.
 C.McCrorie will send out message to remind parents that the scheme will focus on branded school wear in the first instance with a view to expand to unbranded depending on it's success moving forward.
- C.McCrorie will look at the items donated to check whether there is a need for anything at the moment, particularly for pupils starting the new school year.
- Discussion regarding setting up a stall for uniform items at the October parents evening.

 is a safety concern will be removed or secured. Current ideas include removing
 current trim trail and replacing with something else e.g. planters, benches,
 goals/ball game equipment.
- Pupils will be asked for their opinion regarding trim trail replacement.
- Discussed potential idea to replace in stages as this would ensure that pupils and parents see effects of fundraising in a shorter time period and will also stagger any future repairs/replacements.
- Focus on sustainability of any items put in.
