

# Let's Take Learning Outside...

## Green Crown

Can you make yourself a crown using twigs, leaves, flowers or anything else you can find outdoors?

## Tipi for Teddy

Can you make a shelter for your toys, inside or outside. You could collect items when out a walk or find them around your home and garden.  
Will it keep them warm and dry?

## Nature Faces

Gather different materials from indoors or outdoors and create a portrait of someone. Can you make them look happy, sad, excited, worried etc.  
What can you use to change how they look?

## Grow something

Can you grow a plant? You could use an old yoghurt carton or a pot. You could use new seeds or the top off of a carrot or onion.  
Did you know if you pop a seed in a sandwich bag with wet kitchen towel and place it somewhere sunny, you can watch as it germinates.

## Assault Course

Can you use things lying around your house or garden to make an assault course for your favourite toy?  
Think about going under, over, through, around, jumping or ducking.

## Get it Sorted

Collect materials on your walk, from your garden or house.  
Can you sort them by size, by colour, by texture? What other ways could you sort them?

## Story Telling

Use materials from your garden or house to make a character.  
Can you tell someone their name, age, where they live, something interesting about them.  
Can you make up a story for your character?

## Count your Steps

How many steps is it to climb your stairs?  
Walk from your bed to the kitchen?  
How quickly can you do 100 steps?  
Can you count in 2s, 5s or 10s as you walk?  
How many steps from your front door to your back door?  
How many steps to walk all the way around your garden?

## Cloud Gazing

Lie back and watch the clouds moving (if its wet you could do this from a window).  
Think about the shapes they make, can you describe them, can you make a story out of them?  
*I can see a giant dinosaur chasing a dog!*
