Drop Off & Pick Up routines

Thank you for being patient with any changes we make to the drop off and pick up routine. There are always teething problems at the start of term and we are hoping that the new routine will make for a smoother transition both in the morning and the afternoon. The changes are:

- Primary 1A, 1B, 1C & 1D will now line up at their entrance door at 8.50am. The class teachers will collect the lines and accompany the children into the cloakrooms.
- Primary 1A & B will continue to exit the school from the classroom doors (at 2.50pm). Primary 1C & 1D will exit out of the door they use to enter the school in the morning.
- Primary 1E arrangements are not changing; they will continue to use their classroom for both entering and exiting the school.
- Primary 2D will exit the school through their cloakroom door (the same door they use in the morning to enter the school).
- Primary 3A and 3B will enter and exit using their classroom doors.
- There are no changes to Primary 4-7 arrangements.
