It should be up and running by the end of next week. Communication will be sent out to help with signing in etc. P1 parents and new parents will also be issued with sign up instructions next week.


The expectations of Seesaw will be explained at the Meet the Teacher sessions.

Medication

If your child requires medication or an inhaler, please contact the school office. You will be required to complete paperwork and to hand the medication into the school.

Can you please ensure children come to school with everything that they need, for example, water bottles, packed lunches, school bags etc. Children should also know the lunch option they are selecting for that day and what their end of day arrangements are. The office staff will always ensure messages are passed on or items handed in late are delivered to classes, however, it does take the staff away from the office which can result in phone calls being missed etc. Thank you for your support with this.













Meet the Teacher – Thursday 5th September

Meet the Teacher will take place on Thursday 5th September. This is an opportunity for you to meet your child's teacher and to learn about the routines of the class. We will be offering 2 sessions; 3.15pm – 4pm and 4.15pm – 5pm. The teacher will do a presentation at 3.30pm and at 4.30pm and the rest of the time will be spent chatting to parents/ carers. For those unable to attend either session, we will send out the teachers' presentations which will contain all information discussed at the event. If you have more than one child in the school, try to pop into each class so that you get to speak to all of your children's teachers.

We will also be launching our Relationships Policy video at Meet the Teacher. There will be two showings of the video, one at 4pm and the other at 5pm. These will take place in the Gym Hall. Following the event, there will be a link on the school website where you can access the video.

Staffing

Every teacher receives weekly Non-Class Contact (NCC) time. This is normally planned in 2-hour blocks. We therefore have NCC teachers who teach the classes for these periods of time. Miss Ritchie covers the P1 classes, Mrs Galbraith for P2, Ms Laing for P3 and P4 classes, and Mr Galloway, Miss Ritchie and Mrs Kennedy for P5-7. This therefore means that your child will have two teachers throughout the week. This is common practice in all schools across Scotland.

We also have some staff who work part-time (4 days per week); and these classes need to be taught by a different teacher one day per week. Mrs Hood, one of our Principal Teachers and the P5/6 teacher, has time out of class to fulfil her remit so her management day is covered by Mr Galloway. Our newly qualified teachers also have a Friday out of class. Staff will be able to talk to you at Meet the Teacher about the key staff who will work with each class throughout the week.

Playground Safety - Bikes

If your child cycles to school, please encourage them to park their bike in one of the bike storage areas and also to lock their bike. For safety reasons, we ask that pupils come off their bikes and scooters as soon as they enter the school grounds.



Playground Safety - Dogs

Dogs are not permitted on school grounds. We have children who are allergic to dog hair and dog saliva and it is therefore crucial that these children do not come into contact with dogs. Thank you for your understanding.

Wet Weather

On wet mornings, P4-7 will be brought into the gym hall from 8.50am to wait until 9am.

School Finish Times

Just a reminder that P1-3 start at 8.50am and finish at 2.50pm. P4-7 start at 9am and finish at 3pm. It is only siblings of P1-3 children who have the option of finishing at 2.50pm.
