Staffing

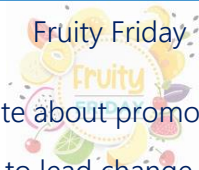

Please speak to your children about Growth and the importance of change in their everyday lives.

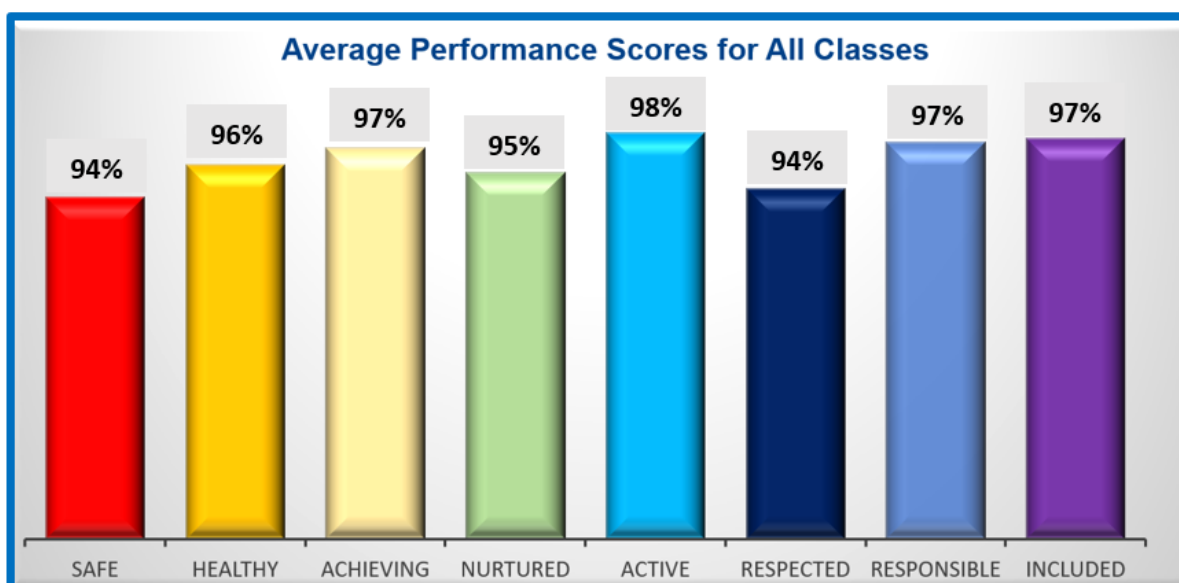
Wellbeing Survey Results – October 2025
