

Digitally literate **learners** should be able to:

- Use school devices and services
- Access learning activities and resources.
- Find, share & evaluate information online.
- Securely access and use devices and online platforms.
- Use digital literacy to create responses or express their thinking on subjects that matter to them.



**Digital** can enhance learning and teaching when considered as part of:


- Planning that meets the needs of learners.
- Teaching that engages learners.
- Learning activities that encourage learners to collaborate, be creative, and apply their skills.
- Assessment that is accessible and captures a range of evidence.
- Feedback that uses video, audio, or markup to explain next steps.





A digitally literate **teacher** should  
be able to:

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- Use school devices and services
  - Keep themselves and their learners safe and secure as possible online.
  - Communicate on different channels with colleagues, learners, and families.
  - Use digital to support and enhance learning & teaching
  - Evaluate their own skills and undertake professional learning to keep up to date with new technology



A **Digital Leader** should set the example in a digital school by:

- Supporting leadership to deliver the school vision.
- Managing devices & apps (timetavle, charging, updates, and evaluating software).
- Supporting staff with examples, training and resources.
- Supporting learners with digital literacy and transitions and additional oppportunities (visits, trips, clubs).
- Celebrating and communicating learners' success with families





## **Schools** that value digital literacy should:

- Articulate a vision of how digital is used in the school and strategy to achieve it.
- Deliver a digital literacy curriculum to learners of all ages.
- Encourage staff to use digital skills that enhance learning.
- Have access to devices and services that are fit for purpose.
- Use data to monitor learner progress over time and to report on their learning journey



## School **leaders** that value digital literacy should:

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- Create and deliver on the school vision and strategy
  - Demonstrate the value of digital throughout the school by offering opportunities & celebrating success.
  - Promote effective use of digital in learning & teaching.
  - Support staff development with protected professional learning time, resources, and digital leaders.
  - Manage technical and legal requirements for devices and platforms.
