

# **Programme Requirements**

Apple Learning Coach is a free professional learning programme for instructional coaches, digital learning specialists and other educators in primary, secondary and higher education, and nonprofit learning environments. Candidates' roles in their schools or local authorities must include instructional coaching of other primary and secondary educators. Programme participation requires approval from school, local authority or nonprofit organisation leadership. For the best experience, we recommend completing the course within 4 months.

# **Application Requirements**

To qualify for the Apple Learning Coach programme, educators must have:

### · Verification of Apple Teacher recognition

 Apple Teacher recognition ensures that Apple Learning Coach candidates have already learnt foundational skills on iPad or Mac; they'll take these skills further during the course.

### · Capacity to coach

- Applicants are required to describe their capacity to coach in the
  application. "Capacity to coach" means the applicant's role will allow
  them to coach at least one primary or secondary educator in a school
  or local authority. The programme defines coaching as partnering with
  teachers to analyse their teaching, set goals, identify strategies to reach
  the goals, and provide support until the goals are met.
- The programme is designed specifically for educators who coach. So a
  condition of admission to the programme is that applicants must be able to
  coach at least one primary or secondary educator once they've completed
  the course. The course content assumes that all Apple Learning Coaches
  work in a school or local authority.

## · Approval from school, local authority or organisation leadership

- All applicants need written approval from their school, local authority or organisation leadership to participate in the programme.
- To begin the ethics approval process, applicants will be asked to provide their leadership's contact information.

# **Course Expectations**


To complete this course, candidates must:

- Read all sections in every unit
- Earn 100 per cent on all quizzes in each unit
- · Submit a completed journal for each unit
- · Attend and actively participate in two days of virtual workshop sessions
- Submit a completed Coaching Portfolio at the end of Unit 6

Candidates will learn more about these expectations if accepted into the programme.

# **Programme Benefits**

Depending on local and national policies, participants may be eligible to receive continuing education units. School and local education authority leaders can also consider qualifying the Apple Learning Coach programme for at least 43.5 hours of professional development.

## **Course Overview**

Apple Learning Coach candidates who are accepted into the programme will engage in an online course that consists of self-paced units and two days of virtual workshops with Apple Professional Learning Specialists. The experience provides participants with a network of fellow coaching educators, as well as Coaching Journals and actionable takeaways. It culminates in a Coaching Portfolio, which participants submit as their final assessment at the end of the programme.



# **Technology Requirements**

The Apple Learning Coach programme teaches coaching skills for creatively integrating technology into learning. The programme incorporates Everyone Can Create to inspire participants and model activities and projects that engage students more deeply in learning. Participants will need an iPad and the free resources below to complete the projects. Visit the Everyone Can Create projects.



**Note:** Guidance for coaching teachers includes Mac examples when possible, but for the best experience with Apple Learning Coach, participants and their schools should have access to iPad with iPadOS 16 or later. Some app features require iPadOS 16.2 or later. Drawing activities are designed for iPad Pro or iPad (6th generation or later) and Apple Pencil. All apps are free and available on the App Store or included with iPadOS.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## How much does the programme cost?

There's no fee to participate.

### Does the programme have prerequisites?

Applicants must earn their Apple Teacher recognition in the Apple Education Community to gain foundational skills with Apple technology before they're accepted into the programme.

Applicants also need to submit an application and get written approval from their school, local authority or organisation leadership.

#### What's the time commitment?

The estimated time commitment for completing the certification course is 43.5 hours, including a one-hour virtual Kickoff and two days of virtual workshops.

### What will participants gain?

Apple Learning Coach provides participants with a full course, actionable guides and templates, and a cohort of peers. Apple Learning Coaches may also be eligible to earn more than 40 hours of continuing education units.

Certified coaches will get exclusive access to virtual meetups, which provide a platform for reconnecting with peers and delving deeper into the knowledge and skills acquired during the course. These gatherings offer a valuable opportunity to exchange insights and refine coaching techniques. Certified coaches will also retain access to the course content, as well as a dedicated space in the Apple Education Community to support and enhance their skills.
