Before you travel

The facility exists to upload important travel and medical details to a secure personal site – this can be accessed via Travel Angel at My LifeLine - the policy number : 0010608847 will require to be entered to register on the site.

The site also provides advice on personal security, travel health issues, street crime, robbery, terrorism and unrest and can provide SMS and e-mail alerts to keep employees travelling abroad appraised of changing political situations or severe weather conditions which could disrupt the organised trip.

While on the trip

You should keep with you, the details you require to contact the insurers directly for any support required. You should note that the council's travel insurance is with AIG and the **policy number is 0010608847**

The contact number for access to assistance in relation to **Medical and Emergency Travel matters is +44 (0) 1273 552922**.

The Emergency Medical Assistance Helpline centre based in Shoreham, provides access to a 24/7 helpline which is staffed by multilingual staff experienced in dealing with hospitals and clinics worldwide. hospitalised person having to front any medical fees for treatment, sourcing and transportation to the most suitable medical facility and repatriation where required.
